RULES:

Gymnasts who have competed in BDP Grades 14 and 13 may enter at any level.
Gymnasts who compete in these levels may NOT enter the Regional Recreational Apparatus competition.

Gymnasts competing in the County Recreational Grades may enter at any level.

Gymnasts who have competed in BDP Grade 12 may only enter at Level 5 minimum.

Gymnasts who have competed in BDP Compulsory Grade 5 can only enter at Level 5 (in age)

Gymnasts who have competed in BDP Club Grades 11-9, or National grades, may NOT enter the Recreational Levels 6 or 5.

A gymnast who enters Individual Level 5 cannot enter Individual level 4 in the same year.

A gymnast may enter Individual Level 5 and Level 4 team in the same year.

- The top gymnast overall in each age group will be awarded a trophy.

- Medals will be awarded to the gymnasts achieving 1st, 2nd and 3rd places overall in each age group. Rosettes or ribbons will be awarded to 4th, 5th & 6th place gymnasts.

- In the Apparatus final, a smaller trophy will be awarded to the gymnast achieving overall 1st place on each piece of apparatus.

- In the Apparatus final, medals will be awarded to the gymnasts achieving overall 1st, 2nd and 3rd places on each piece of apparatus.
