All exercises will be judged out of 13.50 with the FIG Code of Points Table of General Faults being applied for evaluating the final mark.

RULES:

As per the British Gymnastics Grade Regulations.

Please take note of the BDP Grades Book for specific apparatus penalties.

If a gymnast has passed Compulsory 2, she CANNOT compete in Club Grades under any circumstances. However, if she has entered Compulsory 2 and failed, or had to withdraw, then she MAY enter Club Grades.

If a gymnast has qualified for the British Championships via the Challenge Cup and intends to enter the British Championships the following year, she MAY NOT enter the Club Grades.

If a gymnast has competed in the British Championships, she is INELIGIBLE to compete in Club Grades.

Only a failed Club Grade may be re-taken.

All Grades should be taken in a forward and developmental progression eg 2011 Club Gr 14; 2012 Grade 13 or Compulsory 4; 2013 Compulsory 3;

To pass the grade and be eligible for the Regional Final, the top three gymnasts at Grades 14 and 13 must score at least 36.00 on Vault/Bars/Beam/Floor.

For Grades 12/11/10/9, to pass the grade and be eligible for the Regional Final the highest three scoring gymnasts in each age group, scoring over 36.00 will go through.

NOTES:

Certificates & badges will be presented to every gymnast achieving a pass mark.

Trophies will be presented to gymnasts achieving 1st place in each age group in each Grade.

The Frank Stevens Trophy to be awarded to the gymnast/s achieving the highest overall score on Beam in Grades 14, 13 and 12. These are returned annually.
